

Tour a piece of San Jose history: The current McAlister house in Spanish Revival style was built in 1929 on the street named after Capitan John McAlister who owned 38 plus acres of land off Bascom Avenue in San Jose. These acres were once full of prunes, pears, cherries, peaches, almonds & walnuts.

Unfortunately, the first home erected by Capitan McAlister in 1893 tragically burnt down, the present Spanish Colonial Revival was then built on the same site. Although, the first is no longer present, the original palm and avocado trees planted so long ago are still standing in the backyard.

This home is a sprawling 3,118 spare feet and a "dream home" to the current owners. The interior has many architectural features like the vast ornamental wooden ceiling in the spacious front room, the original tiled fireplace, and some beautiful and unique refurbished hardwood flooring.

The new owners continue to work tirelessly in restoring this home and fostering its quintessential charm while attempting to honor its history. There is a large front room, dining room, 4 bedrooms, 3 baths, a sunroom, basement, and 3 balconies. Seize this unique chance to explore a historic residence.
